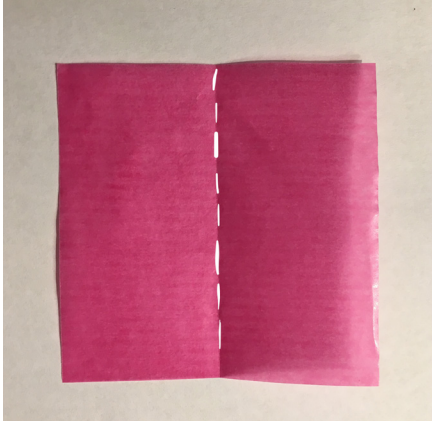


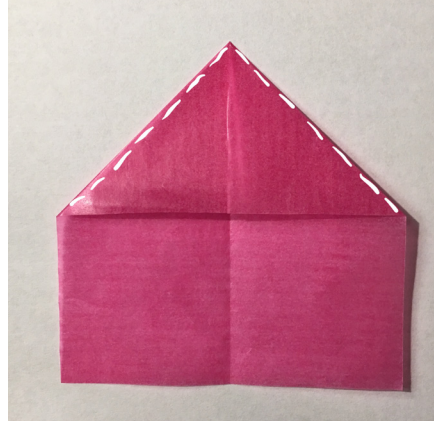
Supplies:

8 sheets of kite paper  
glue stick or school glue

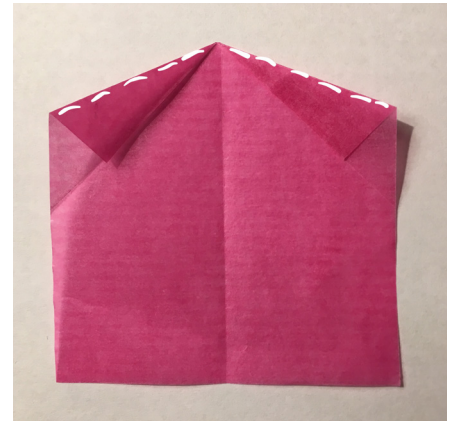
# Square Window Star



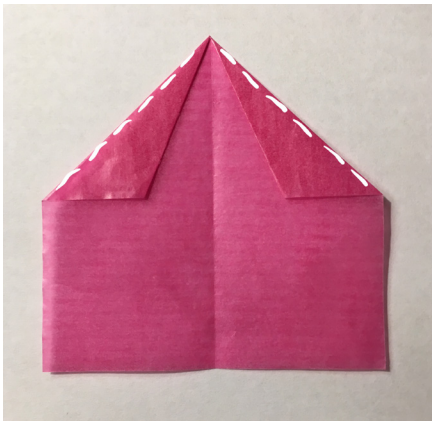
Step A: Start with one sheet of kite paper and fold it in half. Unfold it and your kite paper will now be back to the original square shape with a sharp crease going through the middle.



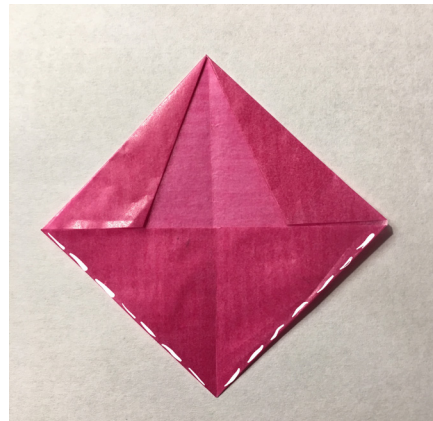
Step B: Fold the upper corners in and down toward the center crease (as if you were creating a paper airplane) and then unfold to create two new creases.



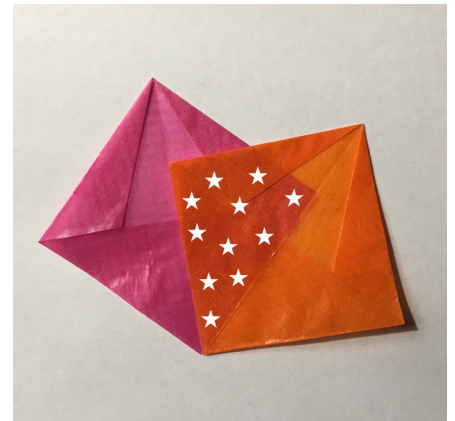
Step C: Fold the upper corners again, this time only toward the new creases made in Step B. Fold over one more time as shown in Step B.



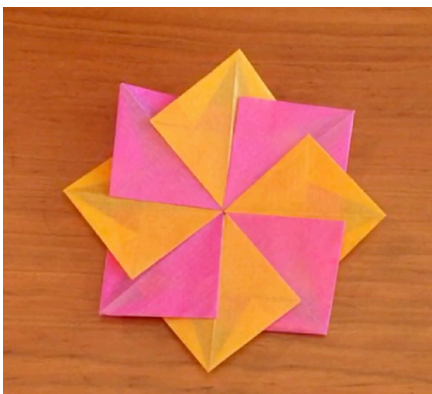
Step D: Fold over one more time as shown. Glue the folds down.



Step E: Fold the bottom corners all the way to the center crease and glue down. Repeat steps A-E until you have all 8 points folded.



Step F: Assemble your star by aligning the lower left side of one point on the center crease of another point, with bottom corners touching. Glue where the white stars are in the picture above.



Step G: Continue in this way around the circle until you have one point left. There should be just enough room for you to insert this point in place and complete the circle.
